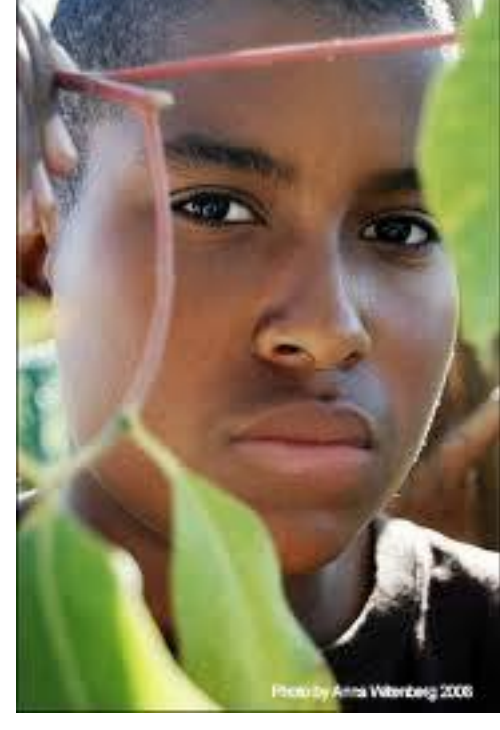
THE APPLE OF MY EYE...
